Terms & Conditions of Rostons Online Fodder Sale

Vendors

1. The vendor to accurately complete an entry form for each lot taking care to describe the quantity and quality for cataloguing. The vendor to provide a photograph for each lot.
2. Bales are all deemed to be of similar quality unless stated to the contrary.
3. The vendor is to allow potential purchasers to inspect lots at any mutually convenient time.
4. A reserve price may be put on each lot if required.
5. The vendor to state if loading assistance can or cannot be provided and if there are any access issues.
6. The vendor to state if delivery is offered and what the maximum distance is. Delivery is to be charged at £1 per mile, each way, unless you wish to include free delivery within a certain radius.

Purchasers

1. The purchaser to bid online for the lots based on the description in the catalogue provided by the vendor.
2. Pre inspection of lots permitted by contacting the auctioneers for the vendors details.
3. The purchaser has 7 DAYS from the sale day to register any complaints about description or quality to the auctioneers. NO CLAIM PERMITTED after this time.
4. Fodder cannot be removed until cleared payment has been received in full.
5. Payment of lots to be made by debit card or BACS within a week of the sale to Rostons.
6. Collection of each lot is the sole responsibility of the purchaser who shall indemnify the vendor if any damage caused to his property during removal.
7. Collection/delivery within a week of the sale, or later by agreement between parties.
8. Where the online catalogue states an exact number of bales sold it is up to the purchaser to make his/her own arrangements to confirm the correct number is counted and loaded.
